**Subject:** Cooperative Agreements for Livonia Transition Program

The Livonia Transition Program (LTP) addresses the vocational needs of students with disabilities between the ages of 18-26 years and is located on Schoolcraft College Campus. LTP has been located at Schoolcraft for the past three years.

We have cooperative agreements with Northville, Redford Union, Crestwood, South Redford and are adding Garden City for the 2018/2019 school year. We charge the resident district a flat fee of \$15,000 and the resident district receives the state aid for their students.

We continue to work on building our base of local businesses that support our students. We have students currently working at Schoolcraft, Goodwill, Cintas, Brookdale, Brighton Gardens, Star Fish, Idyl Wyld, MOD pizza, and Midwest Dental Supply. We also have a Project Search site which is housed at Embassy Suites. For our current enrollment we have had five students exit early with full time employment and at Project Search nine students have jobs lined up for after the end of this year.
