Current Administrative Procedures



- Student registers online at appropriate campus (<u>Student Services</u> / <u>Now Enrolling</u>)
- Grade level verification
 - Homeschool transcript from an accredited program
 - Grade Placement test (third party administered)

Possible Decisions



KISD Board opts out prior to September 1, 2025, by adoption of Board Policy. Does not allow homeschool children to participate in UIL events.

OR

KISD Board takes no action and allows homeschool children to participate in UIL events starting September 1, 2025.

YES/NO

KISD accepts only in-district homeschool students in year one to assess numbers and refine processes.
