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On January 7, 2021, a sixth donation totaling **\$71,400** received from Bio ridge Pharmaceutical Company offered by Mylan's EPIPENS4SCHOOLS Program. Health Services Department received 2-Pak (Epinephrine) Auto-Injectors 0.3mg and Epi-Pen Jr 2-Pak (Epinephrine) Auto-Injectors 0.15mg. These Epi-Pens 2-Pak are worth **\$700.00** each and the district received a total of **51** boxes of pediatric Epi-pens and **51** boxes of adult Epi-pens or **102** boxes.
