Process

- By January 24, 2006, a committee composed of administrators, teachers, parents and students was formed.
- The first meeting of the committee was on January 26, 2006.
- Additional Meetings were held on February 23, March 28, April 27, May 25, June 13, June 20, July 13 and August 24.

The Committee:

- Reviewed literature related to scheduling.
- Conducted site visits of successful schools using a variety of schedules.
- Reviewed academic achievements of Keller ISD students.
- Conducted a survey of parents, teachers and students.
- Created a proposal and implementation timeline including sample schedules.
