Professional Learning

- Teachers K-12 have worked together in June to outline curriculum and instruction plans for the 2025-2026 school year. There was a strong push to study the depth and complexity of the standards so that we can adjust instruction according to the complexity of the standard. K-6 lead teachers were trained in Tier 1 instructional practices. Grades 7-12 have also worked collaboratively this month to ensure TEKS are aligned with instruction and assessments.
- District and campus leadership teams will be participating in two days of leadership training including legal updates and collaborating to ensure campus teams are prepared to roll out common district initiatives in August. K-6 Administrators will also participate in two days of Conscious Discipline training for administrators so they are better equipped to assist teachers with significant student challenges.
- Professional Development plans have been made for teachers returning in August.
- We will hold a district wide instructional conference on August 7. There are over 85 sessions being offered and presented by HISD personnel and other experts in their fields. Sessions were developed based on information taken from a teacher interest survey. Teachers selected sessions before they left in May. New teachers will be registered for the conference at their induction and will take sessions designed to help support teachers new to our district or new to the profession.

Curriculum and Instruction/Assessment

- State Assessment Reporting:
 - Preliminary data from spring TELPAS and STAAR test administrations has been released, and results are overall favorable.
 - TELPAS (Emergent Bilingual students only) results are expected to be available in the state's online Family Portal on June 12, 2025.
 - Spring STAAR EOC preliminary results are expected to be available in the state's online Family Portal on June 10, 2025, with complete final results available July 16, 2025.
 - Results for STAAR Alternate 2, for a small group of students who receive special education services and do not take the regular STAAR test, are expected to be available in the state's online Family Portal on June 24, 2025.

- Grades 3-8 Spring STAAR results are expected to be available in the state's online Family Portal on June 17, 2025 with complete final results available July 25, 2025.
- June EOC testing will occur June 23-26, 2025, and will conclude state testing for the 2024-2025 school year.
- June STAAR EOC preliminary results are expected to be available in the state's online Family Portal on July 31, 2025, with complete final results available September 3, 2025.
- A state assessment report will be shared with the board by September 22, 2025.
