Purpose of Report

The purpose is to present the proposed calendar for the 2016-2017 school year.

Objectives

Review calendar for start date, number of instructional days, scheduled holidays

Operational Impact

State law requires that school not begin before the fourth Monday in August. District teachers and administration have prioritized the following as important considerations:

- Ending the first semester before the December holiday break,
- Keeping both semesters as equal as possible regarding the number of class days,
- Maintaining the school holiday schedule consistent with prior years' schedules including a full week at Thanksgiving, and two weeks in December-January,
- Mirroring the spring break schedule of the University of North Texas and Texas Woman's University and matching as many neighboring districts as possible

The proposed 2016-2017 calendar includes the same number of professional development and teacher preparation days, early release days for exam grading at the secondary level and parent-teacher conferences at the elementary level. The inclement weather make up days coincide with Easter weekend, April 14-17.

Results

Input is currently being sought from the administrative team, teachers, the District Improvement Council and the Board of Trustees. A final recommendation for the 2016-2017 calendar will be made at the November 10 meeting. Approving the 2016-2017 calendar will allow staff and parents time to plan activities for the next school year.

Other Options

Staff could be directed to develop a new calendar proposal for future consideration.
