As we welcomed students and staff back from winter break, CEMS has hit the ground running. MAP testing has begun and will continue through the end of the month, providing valuable data to celebrate student growth and guide instruction. Students are participating in a variety of opportunities, including CES swimming lessons, CMS wrestling, and the Federal Subsistence Art Contest. In addition, CMS has launched new elective courses this semester, with first-hour options in Art, Journalism, or Band, and sixth-hour options in Drama, Health/PE, or SEALs. This report highlights recent staffing updates, current enrollment, extracurricular programs, assessment progress, and upcoming events as we move into the second half of the school year.

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## **CEMS Staffing Updates**

I am pleased to share several positive staffing updates. We have recently filled the CMS long-term social studies substitute position. Jessica Hughes, a retired CHS teacher, has stepped in to support our students through the remainder of the school year, and her experience and willingness to help are greatly appreciated.

We have also filled the CMS wrestling head coaching position. Alex Vickers will serve as head coach, assisted by Hunter Fitch. Both are CHS alumni and former wrestlers. We wish them the best of luck as they lead our wrestling program this season.

Finally, another success worth celebrating is that all paraprofessional vacancies have been filled for this school year. We recently hired Daisy McNamara and Tina Nelson as paraprofessionals, completing our staffing for the special education department. We are pleased to welcome Daisy and Tina to the CEMS team.

Several upcoming positions have been posted, including a 4th grade teacher at CES, an English/Language Arts teacher and a Science teacher at CMS, and a K-12 Health/PE teacher. We look forward to welcoming qualified candidates to these important roles.
