Enrollment and Attendance

Head Start's average daily attendance was 76%. Early Head Start's average daily attendance was 64%. We had one student drop from the Head Start 4-year old room, and we're actively looking to fill it.

Education & School Readiness

Staff is continually assessing classroom needs.

COR/CLASS Report

Teachers continue to enter COR.

Mental Health

Mental health referrals and resources were given to all families with need.

Disabilities

EHS is serving one student with a diagnosed disability and HS is serving four students. Services are being provided for students with need. Mid-year DECA's are due in February.

Nutrition

Lake Orion Community Schools Food Service is providing meals. Nutrition policies and procedures adhered to. The Head Start contracted nutritionist came and did file reviews and growth referrals.

Family & Community Engagement

We had the youth librarian from the Lake Orion Public Library out for her monthly reading time with all classes.
