Staffing Updates

Sports

 - Colton Kuprienko is currently 13th in the entire nation in total points scored
- **Volleyball** is off to a hot start at 4-1 to start the season.
 - Raygn Turner is currently 12th in the state in all classifications in hitting percentage with a .291
 - Jayda Storro is 3rd in 3A in assists with 96
- Girls **soccer** has the most participation it has had in years with no seniors on the team.
