Looking Backwards:

Study Lunch has been successful for many of our classes; more students are turning their assignments in and not getting zeros.

Saturday School: We have added Saturday School for those students who need more time and support. Homedale High School honor society students are volunteering their time to come to Saturday school to tutor some of our at risk students who need help in some of their core subjects. They are receiving community service hours for their efforts.

After School HELP Program is continuing each Monday through Thursday from 3:15 – 4:15

SAT Test Prep classes are being provided in the mornings for juniors from 7 - 8 each Monday and Thursday.

Human Right Student Leadership Team: This group of six Homedale High School students have all been participating in a service learning online class. They are overseeing a dodge ball tournament during lunches 3-4 days per week. The goal of this intramural program is to promote the Eights Habits of the Heart at Homedale High School. The teams are made up of students and even a few staff members. It has been a lot of fun for the students and teachers. Also, each week the students have been promoting a different theme from the book Eights Habits of the Heart.



February 15, 2014 FAFSA: All senior students are being helped with their FAFSA forms, and assistance is being offered to parents of senior students in filling these forms out, during school hours or after school. Appointments are made with Debbie Flaming, school counselor for this.

February 18, 2014 U-STRIVE: Approximately 25 Homedale High School Juniors filled out applications to participate in the U-STRIVE program. They traveled to Boise State University to meet with their BSU Honors student mentors on Saturday March 1st. They started meeting with their mentors on Wednesday March 5, 2014.



Homedale High School Seniors met HHS Alumni currently holding high-profile jobs in state government in Boise on February 19th. HHS seniors who participated were Jasmin Zeggar, Kylee Jenkins, Esteban Lejardi, Tell Hyer, and Emileen Noblit. Two staff also attended this event Debbie Flaming and Katie Anzalone. February 20, 2014 Lock Down Drill occurred at the High School with Homedale Police Department present. We did have some issues, but we will continue to train and practice. We will conduct another Lock Down Drill, a Fire Drill and possibly a Security Lock Down with drug dogs this month.

March 10, 2014 Source of Strength: Debbie Flaming was chosen to be 1 of 14 trainers in the state of Idaho to be a Source of Strength trainer. She will be attending a two day training beginning on March 10th that will certify her as a trainer for this program. The purpose of this program will be to address teen suicide, bullying, and many other problems that teens encounter during their 12 years in the public school system. Homedale High School plans to participate in the Source of Strength training for the entire staff sometime during the 2014-15 school year.
