# BEMIDJI AREA SCHOOLS DISTRICT GOALS 2018-2021

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### Bemidji Area Schools Board Goals

Mission: Empower each learner to succeed in our diverse and changing world.

### Strategy One: Equitable Student Achievement

- 1. Bemidji Area Schools will achieve the highest level of success for ALL students.
- Bemidji Area Schools will develop and implement a vertical vision for a comprehensive Pre-K to 12th Grade program.
- 3. Bemidji Area Schools will demonstrate high academic standards for all students and will close the achievement gap.

#### Reading Goals:

Reading Goal-Grades Kindergarten - Third - 2018-2021: In support of all students Read Well By Third Grade, Bemidji Area Schools Kindergarten through third grade students will increase from 56.75% of the students to 62.75% of the students reaching the Spring Mean Average RIT score identified by the NWEA Reading Assessment:

- \*Kindergarten Spring Mean Average RIT Target 158.1
- \*First Spring Mean Average RIT Target 177.5
- \*Second Spring Mean Average RIT Target 188.7
- \*Third Spring Mean Average RIT Target 198.6

Reading Goal-Grades Third-Tenth-2018-2021: The Bemidji Area Schools district-wide "All Students" group will increase their proficiency of 57.17% in the Spring of 2018 to 63% in the Spring of 2021 as measured by the MCA Reading Assessment and identified on the North Star Report.

Goal 1A: The Bemidji Area Schools will close the achievement gap for the following subgroups as measured by the MCA Reading Assessment and identified on the North Star Report.

Special Education students' proficiency will improve from 29.23% in the Spring of 2018 to 35.23% in the Spring of 2021.

American Indian students' proficiency will improve from 35.76% in the Spring of 2018 to 41.76% in the Spring of 2021.

Free and Reduced Lunch students' proficiency will improve from 46.69% in the Spring of 2018 to 52.69% in the Spring of 2021

# MCA ACCOUNTABILITY INDICATORS

## Minnesota's Accountability Indicators



### Academic Achievement: all schools

The number of students at the "Meets Standards" or "Exceeds Standards" achievement levels divided by all students in tested grades. Calculated separately for **math** and **reading**. Students who do not participate (unless medically exempt) are counted as "not proficient."



### Progress Toward English Language Proficiency: all schools

The average progress English learners made toward individual growth targets on the ACCESS for English Language Learners test.



### Academic Progress: elementary and middle schools

A score based on students' achievement levels from one year to the next. Calculated separately for math and reading using a transition matrix that awards points for increasing achievement levels (e.g., moving from "does not meet standards" to "partially meets").



### Graduation Rates: high schools

The percentage of students who graduated in four years and seven years. Students who drop out after less than half an academic year at a school will be counted at the high school they attended for the most time.



### Consistent Attendance: all schools


The percentage of students attending more than 90 percent of the days they are enrolled.

\*The Bemidji Area School District scored a 51.98% on the 2019 MCA Mathematic Assessment Our district result was 1.87% below the state.


\*The Bemidji Area School District scored 55.56% on the 2019 MCA Reading Assessment. Our district result was 2.72% below the state.





\*The Bemidji Area School District scored a 27.73% on the 2019 MCA Mathematic Assessment Our district result was 1.83% above the state.


\*The Bemidji Area School District scored 37.08% on the 2019 MCA Reading Assessment. Our district result was 3.1% above the state.







### 2018 MCA Graduation:

\*The Bemidji Area School District on the 2019 Four Year Graduation Rate increased from 75.85% in 2018 to 76.34 in 2019. Our result was 6.86% below the state.

\*The Bemidji Area School District on the 2019 Seven Year Graduation Rate decreased from 79.67% in 2018 to 79.57% in 2019 Our result was 7.96% below the state.




\*The Bemidji Area School District attendance rate increased from 72.11% in 2018 to 84.50% in the 2019 school year. Our result was .85% below the state.




# 2019 MCA Consistent Free and Reduced Attendance:
