Agenda Topic: Police/School Liaison Interlocal Agreement City of Denton

Guiding Outcome: Reciprocal Family & Community Partnerships

Summary: This item requests approval of the Police/School Liaison Interlocal Agreement between the City of Denton and Denton ISD whereas City of Denton shall provide Denton ISD with six certified police officers to serve as school resource officers (SROs) (assignments below).

Background Information/
Previous Board Action: This is a service provided by The City of Denton to assist our schools in their jurisdiction with School Resource Officers. Each of the following schools will be assigned 1 (one) SRO:
Denton High School, Ryan High School, Guyer High School, Calhoun Middle School, Strickland Middle School, McMath Middle School.

The Denton ISD Board of Trustees have approved similar agreements with the City of Aubrey, Denton County Sheriff's Department, Town of Little Elm, and the City of Oak Point to provide SROs to our campuses in their jurisdiction.

Potential Operational Impact: Establishes and delineates the mission of the SRO Program. Also, formalizes relationships between the participating entities to foster an efficient and cohesive program that will build a positive relationship with the youth of the community.

Potential Financial Impact: FY 2026-2027, Estimated DISD Billing: \$511,111 (compared to \$508,392 in FY26)

Recommendation (Consent or New Business Only): Approval of the SRO MOU between the City of Denton and Denton ISD where the City of Denton will provide six certified police officers.
