Background Information:

There are several components to the 2010 Summer School plan. We are continuing to offer ESL Summer School for entering Kindergarten and First Grade LEP students as well as Extended Year Services for eligible Special Education Students. Grade 5 Reading and Math and Grade 8 Reading and Math students who are not successful on the second administration of TAKS will be in a summer school program to prepare them for third TAKS administration in July. In addition, we will offer an Exit Level session for students who have not passed any portion of the Exit Level TAKS. Pam Wood at the high school will once again be offering a UIL Math Camp for entering 6th, 7th and 8th graders.

As we did last year, we plan to have an ESL Summer School program for all of our non-English speaking students. This course is designed to help children understand and speak English. Students who will be enrolled in grades 2 through 12 next school year and who are non-English to very limited English are eligible to attend. All students living in Cactus and Etter will attend Cactus Elementary and students who live in Dumas will attend Morningside Elementary. The students will be scheduled in hour blocks and will be utilizing the Rosetta Stone computer program as well as the Symphony Math computer program.
