Policy #3700

Policy Name: *Safety Regulations*

Regulation: -----

The safety of students of School District No. 9 takes precedence over all other factors involved in the school program. Student safety shall be a primary consideration in the development of policies, handbooks and school procedures.

- Teachers and school staff assigned to supervise students are responsible for the safety of students in their charge.
- The school bus driver or school employees providing transportation to students will engage in safe transport. Students on a bus or a school vehicle will be provided with instruction regarding safe passenger practices and supervised for safe behavior.
- Safe pedestrian practices shall be taught frequently in elementary schools. This applies particularly to walking on the highway, riding bicycles, and leaving and entering school buses.
- Students attending school events and dances will be expected to remain in the school building during the times scheduled for such activities.
- All accidents are to be reported to principals and the school nurse immediately. It shall be the nurse’s responsibility to file a written report to the Superintendent within three (3) days of the occurrence of the accident.
- Students participating in out of town activities and/or field trips under the supervision of the school will be released to parent/guardian. **Students participating under supervision of the school will sign in to verify attendance.** Written approval to release the student to another person must be provided by the parent/guardian in person to the coach/sponsor. **The person checking the student out must sign the check-out sheet with the coach.**
