Summary:	Districts identified with excess local revenue are required to select a contract that reduces its local revenue level in excess of entitlement. The option we are selecting is to purchase attendance credit, which will result in TEA reducing our state aid to cover the recapture amount. The 2025-2026 estimated recapture amount is \$1.6M.
