#### **Timeline**

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Data Pulls (as per Business Rules)	For 2022, the student enrollment data used to determine schools' students who are expected to test in ACT Aspire will be downloaded from TRIAND on <b>April 18</b> and <b>May 16, 2022</b> .
	Schools would need to have any necessary updates to student enrollment and demographics in eSchool by April 15 and May 13, 2022 in order for the updates to be in each data pull. All students in enrollment on April 18 or May 16 will be expected to test.
Testing Window	Grades 3-10 ACT Aspire: April 18-May 20, 2022
Corrections Window	The Assessment Correction Engine (ACE) interface will be available to all districts from <b>August 8 through August 22</b> at the ADE Data Center. Districts MUST use ACE to certify assessment data and MAY submit documentation to remove eligible students from their denominator for expected to test. All data must be certified by the district superintendent no later than 5:00 p.m., August 22, 2022.
