### **CONSENT ITEM**

#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

It is recommended that the Board approve the selection of SpawGlass General Contractors, Inc. to provide the general contractor services for the RFCSP 25-07 Wagner HS Tennis Courts Accessibility Upgrades project in Bond 2016 and that the Board of Trustees delegate the authority to the Superintendent or their designee to execute all contracts and related documents necessary to complete this project. The scope of work includes but is not limited to providing all labor, materials, equipment and accessories for the tennis court accessibility upgrades project at Wagner HS as indicated in the contract documents. Construction will include removing and replacing the existing concrete curbs, flatwork, and asphalt pavement to meet accessibility requirements. Expenditures will be made from Bond 2016 funds at a total estimated cost of \$378,060.00.

## **IMPACT/RATIONALE:**

Allows the district to purchase goods and services in accordance with Section 44.031 of the Texas Education Code. Expenditures will be made from Bond 2016 funds at a total estimated cost of \$378,060.00. The scope of work includes but is not limited to providing all labor, materials, equipment and accessories for the tennis court accessibility upgrades project at Wagner HS as indicated in the contract documents. Construction will include removing and replacing the existing concrete curbs, flatwork, and asphalt pavement to meet accessibility requirements.
