Summary: The district has continually used S.TX School Therapy Providers, Inc. (under CTPA contract with SCUCID #22-023V Supplemental Education Instructional & Related Services) for Special Education services for NISD.

Background Information: Due to service obligations and ARD Committee requirements, we have continued to contract with S.TX School Therapy Providers, Inc. They have worked very well with the district and came highly recommended from neighboring school districts and have been able to meet the District's needs on short notice. PT/OT expenses continue to exceed \$25,000.00 therefore we have continued operating under the CTPA contract adoption through SCUCISD. We will also use them for Adapted PE Services and for evaluations as needed. SCUCISD intends to renew this contract with three additional renewal option years. The rates under this contract continue to be lower than other options explored such as the Region 20 Coop.
