- **7-10% Return on Investment money invested in Early Childhood Education** (Star Tribune, May 15, 2022)
- Long Term Impact of Preschool greater academic success, higher earning s & better health (Perry Study Michigan Through age 40, N.Y. Times, December 2, 2021)
- Children who attended preschool had graduation rates averaging nearly 80% percent, while the graduation rate for those not enrolled was only 60%. (Perry Study Michigan)
- Minnesota ranks 37th in the country in regards to Access to Preschool lowa is 5th. Wisconsin is 7th. (NIEER, 2003)






early Reading

Kindergarten & 1st Grade Fall 2024-2025




