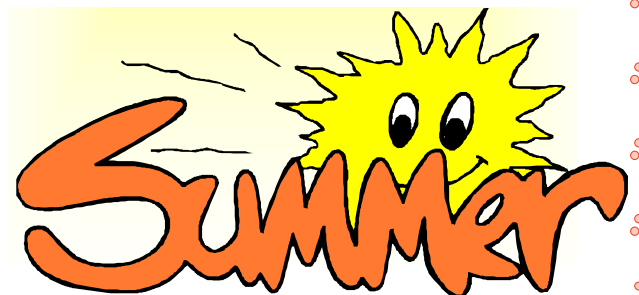

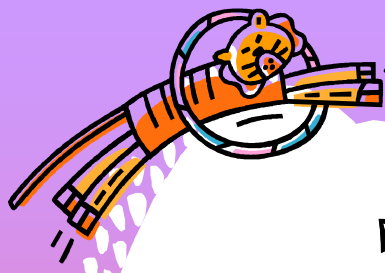

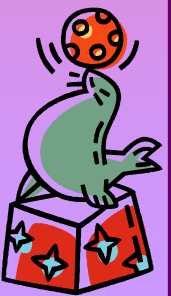

The program begins promptly at 6:00 p.m.

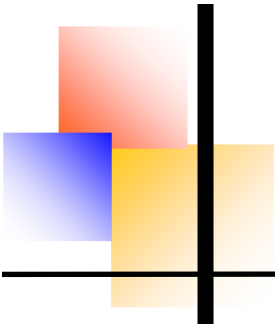


Come listen and sing along with us on May 18th from 6:00-7:00 p.m.

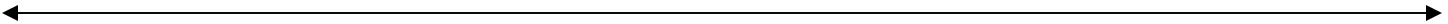




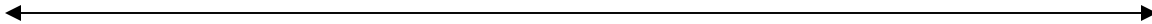

## Book Exchange

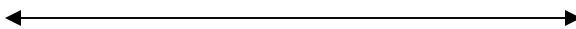
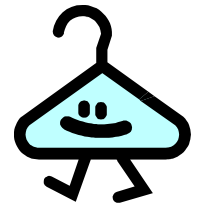

I now have two more places to hang clothes thanks to my husband's handiwork. If you have any youth hangers you are not using, please consider donating them to our program. Thank you!



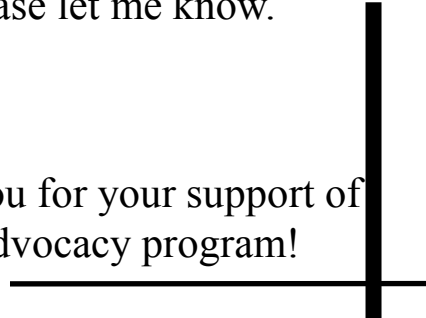
### Advocates Wish List

I have 2 blankets for girls. One is a Disney Princess and the other is Holly Hobby. If you know a little girl that could use a special blanket, please let me know.

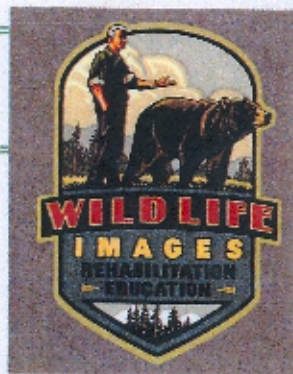

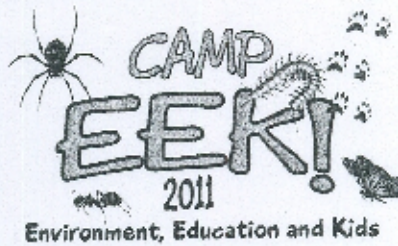
