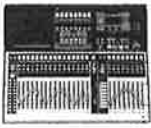

We are not responsible for owner's equipment working/functioning regardless of condition received. Chase pipe diameter should be discussed before installation by either party. All wiring originates in the equipment room and terminates in room locations listed. Incoming service is from outside demarc point to equipment room. Homerun chase pipe originates in the equipment room and goes to location (specified room/attic). Local chase pipe is from TV to in-room location
