Board Policy 861
Public Conduct on School Property and at School Events
Last Revised 9.10.2019

The Board expects that all school employees, students, community members, and other individuals conduct themselves in an orderly and courteous manner at all school sponsored games, activities, events, and meetings. Individuals, regardless of their role in activities, are expected to model good behavior and be aware of their influences on others. Community members also represent the Unity Community.

Events, activities, games and meetings sponsored by the District may be regulated. The attendance of such events may be limited. Unity reserves the right to deny admission or to remove anyone for inappropriate behavior.

No person shall use profane, abusive, threatening, or defamatory language. In addition, acts which are violent, potentially harmful, disruptive, illegal, **harassing**, or destructive will not be tolerated.

Any person involved in any of the above acts or which have or may have the potential for disturbing the school or an activity in any way will face one or more of the following consequences:

- A. Supervisory personnel ~~will~~ **may** advise individual(s) to cease and desist from such disruptive conduct.
- B. Refusal to cooperate with the instructions of supervisory personnel will constitute grounds for immediate removal from the premises.
- C. The assistance of law enforcement may be sought in those instances where an individual refuses to comply with this policy or with other reasonable requests.
- D. The Board **Administration** may ban a disruptive person from attendance at future District activities based on the severity or frequency of the behavior.
- E. A person who has been banned from attendance at future District activities may appeal to the District Administrator to have the ban lifted.
 - The District Administrator may choose to uphold the ban indefinitely, remove the ban after sports season, or require specific action prior to consideration.
 - The decision of the District Administrator is final.**
