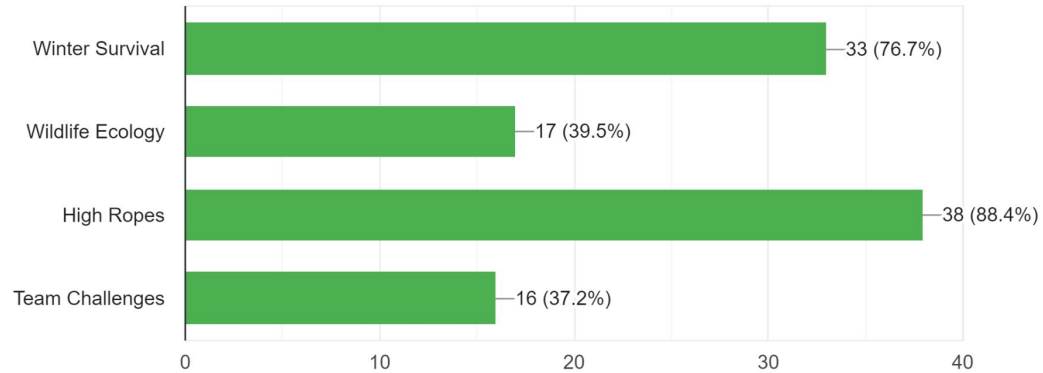

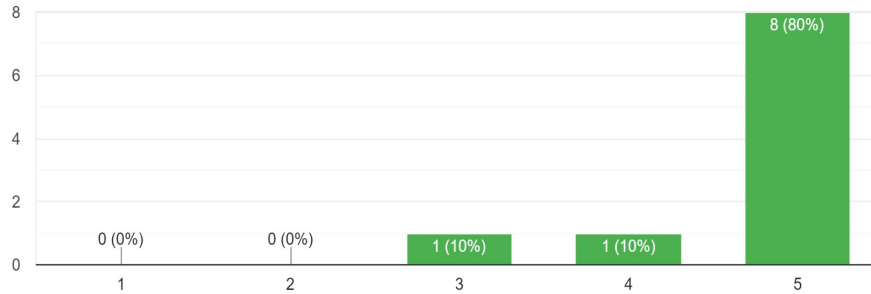

How would you rate the communication you received as a parent with regard to this trip.

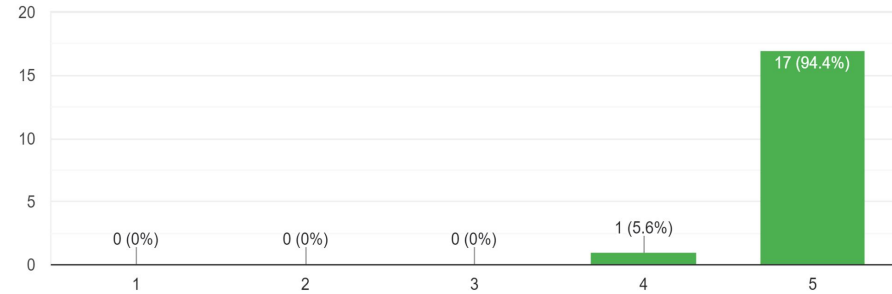

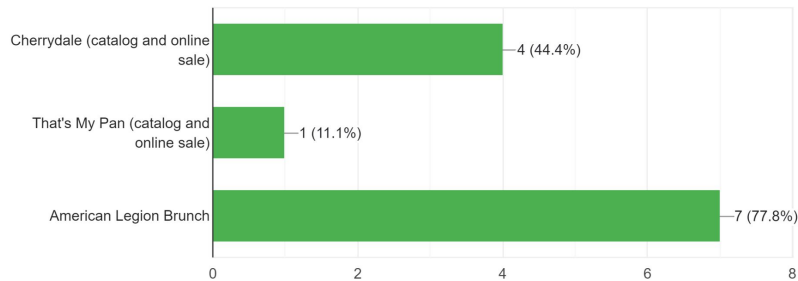

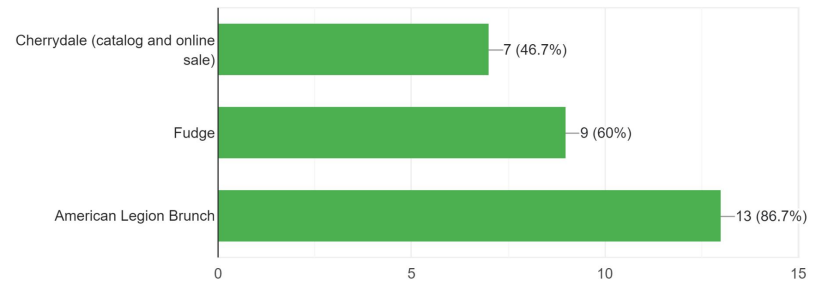
Which fundraisers did you enjoy as a parent? (Check all that apply)

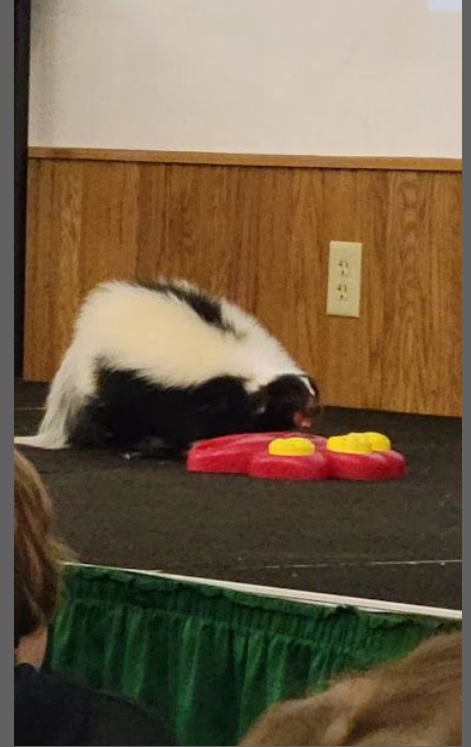
