Agenda Item: Consider Approval of Student School Meal Prices for the 2025-2026 School Year

The Healthy, Hunger-Free Kids Act of 2010 (HHFKA) requires that paid school meal prices be indexed to the federal reimbursement rates for free meals using the Paid Lunch Equity (PLE) Tool.
