TOPIC: Approval to Purchase i-Ready Diagnostics and Licenses

RECOMMENDATION:

Move that the Board of Education approve the recommendation to purchase i-Ready Licenses and Diagnostic Assessments for Math and Reading for use at the elementary and secondary levels from Curriculum Associates. This purchase includes six days of professional development for \$10,500.00. The total cost to purchase the Diagnostic Licenses, i-Ready Reading Instruction, and professional development is \$116,455.20. This total reflects a discount savings of \$37,624.80.

RATIONALE:

The purchase of i-Ready Diagnostic Assessments will provide all kindergarten through eighth grade students with a State of Michigan approved assessment three times a year. This will provide teachers with their students' strengths and weaknesses in reading and math. Additionally, the i-Ready Instructional licenses will be used for targeted students at the elementary and secondary levels.

BUDGETARY INFORMATION:

The funding for this purchase will come from a mixture of Early Literacy Grant funds, 31a At-Risk state funds, and Academic Services Department funds.
