**Boys Basketball**

Our boys team has 5-3 record thus far in the season. Our team had a great time at the All American-Indian Shoot Out in Billings during the opening weekend of the season. We just received a check for \$4,300.00 from the All American-Indian Shoot Out committee.

100% of our student athletes passed the first semester, and are all eligible to continue playing on our team and are also academically eligible for spring sports.

Coaches are working very hard in the gym during practice getting the team ready each week and are building the team's strength for the divisional tournament.

We have had some games rescheduled due to bad weather and Covid.

We are starting to plan for the Special Guest nights for our winter sports programs. January 27, 2022 will be Wrestling Special Guest night. February 5, 2022 will be Boys basketball and Cheerleading Special Guest night. February 17, 2022 will be Girls basketball Special Guest night.

### **Napi Elementary and Browning Middle School**

Napi Elementary is in the process of hiring coaches for BBB and GBB basketball. The season was postponed until Feb 7, 2022 due to recent rise in Covid. Mr. Tail is expecting a large number of 4<sup>th</sup> and
