**TOPIC:**       **Approval to Purchase Secondary Furniture – 2013 Bond**

**RECOMMENDATION:**

Move that the Board of Education of the Livonia Public Schools School District approve the purchase of two-person desks, stand-up desks, and student chairs with arms from Staples Business Advantage in Livonia, Michigan, for a cost of \$202,571.60 and four-leg student chairs from Interior Environments in Novi, Michigan for a cost of \$103,444.64; for a total cost of \$306,016.24.

**RATIONALE:**

This is a planned purchase of classroom furniture for students at middle and high schools and the Western Wayne Skill Center program at Garfield Community School.
