Meal Prices 2025–2026

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Beginning July 1, 2025, Estacada School District will operate district-wide under the *Community Eligibility Provision (CEP)*. This federal option allows the District to serve one free reimbursable breakfast and one free reimbursable lunch to every enrolled student, regardless of household income, for at least the next four school years.

Because all student meals are free, the *Paid Lunch Equity (PLE)* tool and any associated price increases are not required for School Year 2025–2026. Estacada School District qualifies for a formal *PLE exemption* due to CEP participation. The District must still ensure that adult meal prices meet or exceed the current USDA minimums.

Meal Pricing Table:

• All Enrolled Students (Pre-K-12):

Breakfast: Free

Lunch: Free

• Milk alone (8 oz): \$0.65

• Adult Meals (District-wide):

Breakfast: \$2.75*

Lunch: \$5.25*

• Milk alone (8 oz): \$0.65

* USDA minimum pricing for SY 2025–2026.

A reimbursable meal includes the required components defined by the USDA for breakfast or lunch (e.g., fruits, vegetables, grains, protein, and milk) and must be selected in the correct combinations to qualify for federal reimbursement.

Note: Extra or à-la-carte items (e.g., second entrées, bottled beverages) may continue to be sold at published prices and are not covered by CEP.
