BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Texas Charter Schools are required to solicit Statement of Impact responses for the Commissioner from school districts that may be affected by operation or expansion of Charter programs in their attendance areas. We have received Statement of Impact requests from two affiliated Charter operations, Paradigm Charter and Responsive Education.

ADMINISTRATIVE RECOMMENDATION

These requests are affiliated with a projected large-scale expansion of these two open-Enrollment Charters, including potential enrollment of school children from Crockett County. These schools have current operating sites in Del Rio, for instance. As Open-Enrollment Charters are awarded the Basic Allotment / ADA for these students, this draws funding away from public schools. In a fiscal climate where public schools are expected to experience perhaps as much as 15% reductions in Foundation Program support this biennium, my recommendation would be to return these Statements of Impact indicating probable Significant impact on CCCCSD.
