14	• Would not bring unanticipated costs to the school district
15	• Will place no restrictions on the school program
16	• Will be suitable for use in meeting the instructional needs of the school
17	• Will not be inappropriate or harmful to the best educational interests of
18	students, as determined by the administration
19	• Will not imply endorsement of any business or product
20	• Will not be in conflict with any provisions of the school code or public law

22	All gifts, grants and bequests shall become school district property.
