The LINK program serves adults with disabilities and focuses on offering opportunities that promote life skills, independence, networking and knowledge. During the 2017-2018 school year LINK offered 24 activities and averaged 10-12 participants at each activity. Activities included holiday parties, dinners at local restaurants, mini-golf, movie nights, game nights, arts & crafts and many more.

LINK staff members seek feedback from participants regarding what activities they'd like to participate in and then work to develop programming that provides social, recreational and educational experiences for adults with disabilities. We've learned that every event we offer needs to include two things - food and time to hang out with their friends!
