The President announced that the Board of Education would next consider the adoption of a resolution providing for the transfer of \$281,193 from the Transportation Fund to the Operations & Maintenance Fund pursuant to 23 ILL. ADMIN CODE 100.50.

Whereupon Member _____ presented and the Secretary read by title a resolution as follows, a copy of which was provided to each member of the Board of Education prior to said meeting and to everyone in attendance at said meeting who requested a copy:

**RESOLUTION PLEDGING AND AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF
\$281,193 FROM THE TRANSPORTATION FUND
TO THE OPERATIONS & MAINTENANCE FUND**

WHEREAS, the Illinois Administrative Code (23 ILL. ADMIN. CODE §100.50) authorizes the permanent interfund transfer of money from the Transportation Fund to the Operations & Maintenance Fund when revenues or other sources of funds are pledged to pay for a capital project or acquisition; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education finds and determines that it is necessary and in the best interests of the District to pledge \$281,193 in the Transportation Fund to pay for a capital project(s) or acquisition(s); and

WHEREAS, this Board of Education is now authorized to permanently transfer the sum of \$281,193 from the Transportation Fund to the Operations & Maintenance Fund pursuant to 23 ILL. ADMIN. CODE §100.50; and

WHEREAS, this Board of Education deems it advisable, necessary, and in the best interests of the District that \$281,193 be transferred from the Transportation Fund to the Operations & Maintenance Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Education of Geneva Community Unit School District No. 304, Kane County, Illinois as follows:

Section 1. The Board of Education hereby finds that all of the recitals contained in the preambles to this Resolution are full, true, and correct and does incorporate them into this Section 1 by this reference.

Section 2. That the Treasurer of this School District is hereby directed and authorized to transfer and record transfer on or before June 30, 2023, the sum of \$281,193 from the Transportation Fund to the Operations & Maintenance Fund.

Section 3. That all resolutions or parts thereof in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, and this Resolution shall be in full force and effect forthwith upon and after its adoption.
