Takeaways

Read 180 has been a game changer at LBMS. In the last three years we have exited over 30 students that have at one time been more than a grade level behind and now are at grade level.

The story of Keegan

Keegan joined the Lorna Byrne family just this year in 8th grade. He had never been in a formal school environment before this year and came to us not knowing how to read. He didn't even have basic phonics knowledge. What he does have is a positive attitude toward learning and a strong desire to succeed. His initial score in Read 180 was a lexile of 10, which is a non-reader. His mid-year score is a lexile of 80, which is an impressive gain considering the average is 100 points per school year.



The Story of Flint

Flint is currently in 6th grade and began his Read 180 journey last year in 5th. He is probably the hardest working student we have in this school and is never absent. Flint started out in the program in Code, which is the phonics component of Read 180 and he has grown over 600 lexile points. He is now in the comprehension portion of Read 180 and has also shown amazing growth in his writing skills.
