Subject: Policy IGBA Students with Disabilities-Child Find Procedures (Second Reading)

Background: The U.S. Supreme Court ruling on Endrews v. Douglas County School District changed legal interpretations of the IDEA requirement for "Educational Benefit" and Free and Appropriate Public Education (FAPE) for students with disabilities. Oregon Legislators revised Senate Bill 20 to ensure students who receive a modified diploma have the right to return and receive general and special education services through the age of 21.

Proposal: The Revised Policy aligns language around advancing from grade to grade, removes modified diploma as ending FAPE requirements for school districts and adds "high school" reference to diploma. Additionally, this policy clarifies language around required age for enrollment.

Recommendation: Staff recommends approval of Policy IGBA Students with Disabilities Child Find Procedures.
