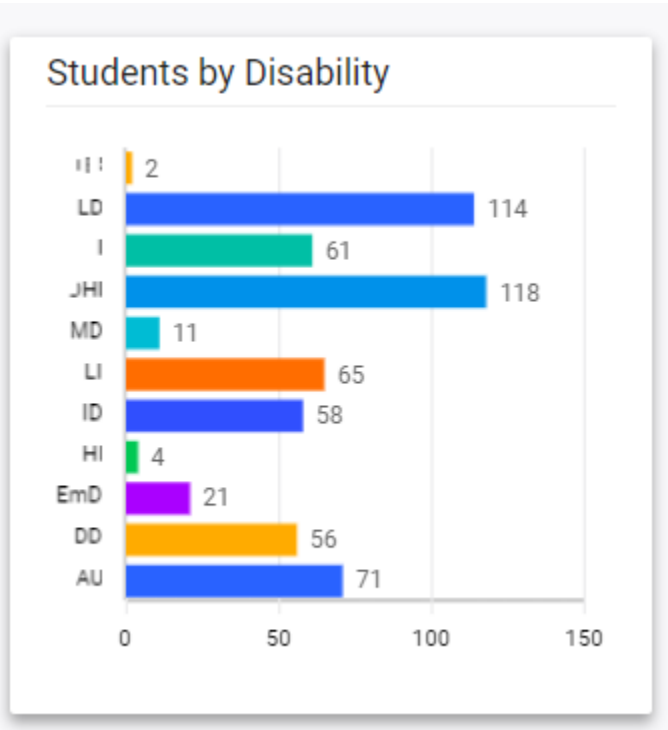


August 2024 Special Education Board Report



We have had a great yet busy start of the school year. On August 7, 8, and 9 professional development was provided to all special education staff. Our first PK screening is scheduled for August 16 to start identifying new PK students and screen students referred to our program through the Infant and Toddler Program.

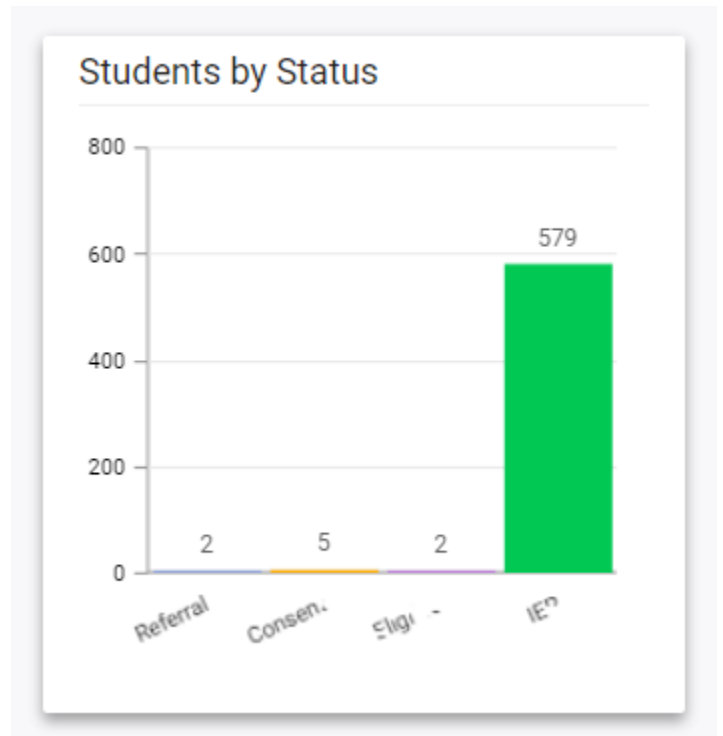
The certified special education staff asked that I thank the board for the \$2500.00 stipend for PD and Paperwork. They are very appreciative of the additional opportunities for PD.

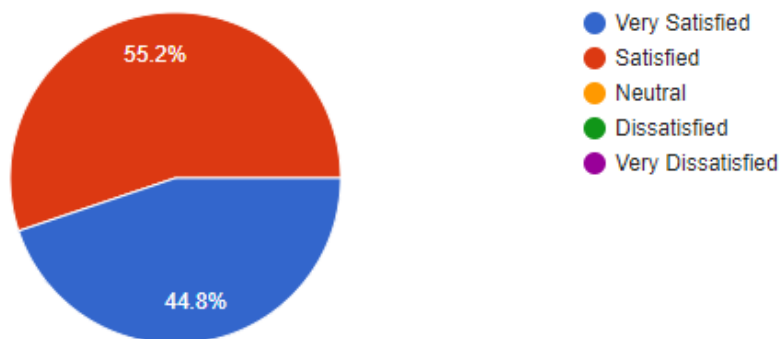

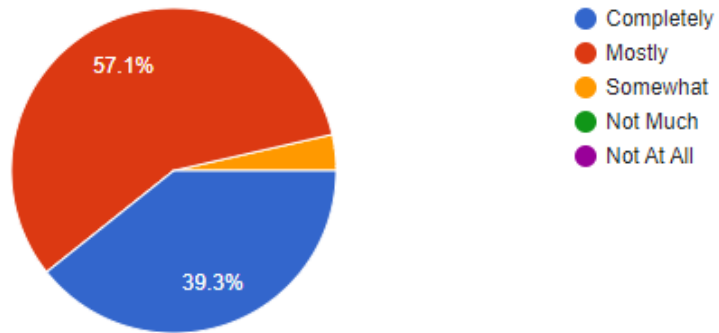

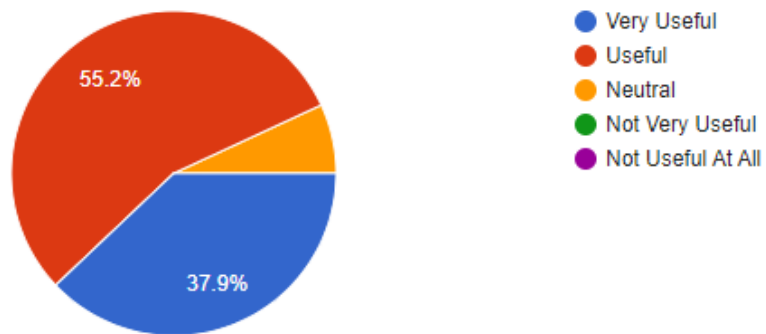

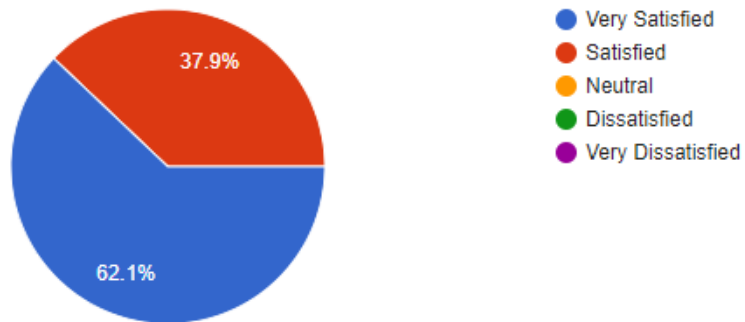

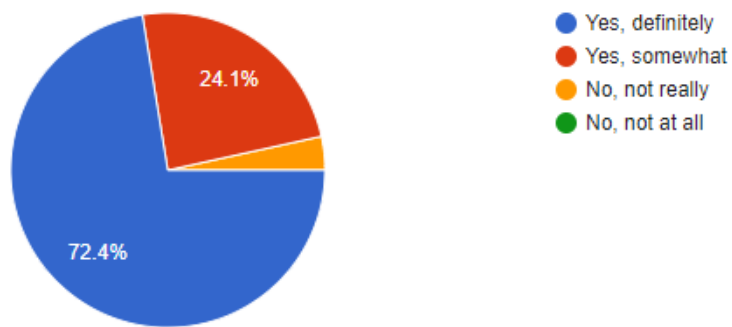

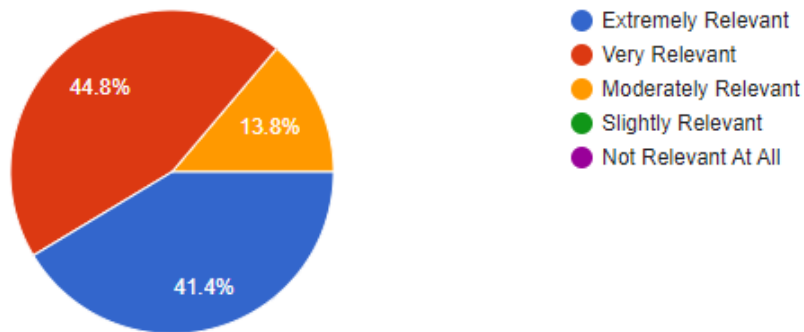
