Title Update- November 20, 2023

Intervention groups have been going well, but we've had a lot of staff shortages. When that happens we do our best to cover the group so our most challenged kiddos have consistency and support. We are currently in the process of assessing all of our 4th grade intervention students in order to shuffle groups a bit. We will be creating smaller groups and graduating some students back into their classrooms for Double Dose Reading.

We are all set to do Winter Benchmark testing when we return from break. The plan is to assess math the week we return and hold off on the individual reading testing until the following week. That will give our students a week to refresh their skills after the break. We will get assessments scored and entered as soon as possible in order to restructure groups at the end of January for Round 3 of intervention.

Boys and Girls Club:

Numbers dropped in December, believed to be from sports and illness. Down 10 kids, currently they see 63 in all. Club alone is around 33. This week of December 18th is Spirit Week. The focus for December has been arts and crafts, triple play challenges. Family night was last week, approximately 35 people attended. They will be closed the week 25th, but will be open for the second week of break (7:45am-5:15pm). January will see a revamp of the Power Hour. Parents have requested assistance with reading and math, and so Power Hour will see more support in those specific areas. Materials have been provided by Evergreen.

Next Steps:

Some teachers will pilot each curriculum for 1 week in Jan/Feb.

T.Campbell will pilot for EV Kindergarten and B. Gilkey will pilot for EV 2nd gd.

Teachers will teach to the same standards/unit focus as their grade level, just use the piloted curriculums.

Late February: STEMScopes and Eureka Math available in schools for teachers to view/provide feedback.

Team meets 3-8-24 for pilot teachers to provide feedback and then the team will make the final decision to recommend to the school board.

PDs will be provided for the selected curriculum.

Professional Development: See notes above regarding math adoption.

- PDs for EAs occurred on December 18th with a focus on handling behaviors and understanding de-escalation techniques.
- Kindergarten team asked about attending an Elevate conference summer of 2024. Next steps of looking into this opportunity is occurring.
