2060 CURRICULUM DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEES

Curriculum Development Committees may be set up for the various areas of learning by the Director of Curriculum, Instruction & Assessment with approval by the Superintendent.

Members of these committees must include teachers, administrative supervisors, and parents. Functions of a Curriculum Development Committee shall include:

- 1. Organize itself into a working body submitting any requests for hiring of consultants to assist in the project to the Superintendent for School Board approval.
- 2. Set up a schedule of meetings with a target completion date.
- 3. Survey various current curricula.
- 4. Develop a recommended new curriculum.
- 5. Select proper text materials, audio-visual aids, and related teaching materials.
- 6. Present proposal to the Director of Curriculum, Instruction & Assessment and the Superintendent.
- 7. Present proposal to the School Board.
- 8. If approved, publish curriculum materials.
