BOARD GOAL: Budget and Finance

FISCAL NOTE: Ancillary Benefits Products

Background Information:

- The District is at the three-year cycle for current benefits and needs to assess the market for enhancement of benefits and pricing.
- Medical and prescription trends indicate a significant increase in costs.
- The District needs to reduce, maintain, or limit current levels of administrative and overall program costs.

Administrative Considerations:

- Keller ISD has been self-funded over the past three years and has enjoyed the current levels of benefits.
- Keller ISD elects to opt out of the penalty section of the Health Insurance Portability Accountability Act (HIPAA).
- Keller controls its own Plan Document and sets its own rates.
- Modification of plans is needed to meet funding demands.

The administration recommends that the Board of Trustees approve the Ancillary Products as presented for the employees of Keller ISD.
