**Maintenance of Effort (MOE):** refers to the requirement placed upon many federally funded grant programs that a subrecipient demonstrate that the level of local funding for a particular program remains relatively constant from year to year. Failure to meet MOE requirements may result in the subrecipient losing eligibility (Eligibility Standard) to receive federal funding or a repayment of funds (Compliance Standard).
