AGENDUM ITEM #3 – Presentation

A. Presentation of 2023-2024 Title IX Report

Secondary Education Assistant Director Matt Williams shared with the Board the Weber School District 2023-2024 Title IX Summary Report required by state code. It was noted the overview of the report shows the district is in great shape. It is to ensure there is equal participation opportunity and equity in sports for students. The following data was shared with the Board:

- 25 High School Sports 13 girls and 12 boy sports.
- 11 Junior High School Sports: 6 girls and 5 boy sports.
- Total participation numbers at high school 2952 students girls 44% boys 56%
- Total participation numbers at junior high 2438 girls 52% boys 48%

The amount of spending that the school devotes to each gender -designated sport, reported in total amount and on a per-student basis examples were shared. Facilities equality and equity amongst facilities chart was also shared with the Board.

A. Administrative Appointment(s)

Superintendent Butters explained with the retirement of Assessment and School Improvement Director Sheri Heiter, we have hired Dr. Bryan Becherini as Assessment and School Improvement Director. Wahlquist Jr. High Assistant Principal Mike Brown's retirement created a vacancy and would like to appoint Administrative Intern Andrew Penland to fill this position. Steve Alder will be an Assistant Principal at T.H. Bell Jr. High. Ryan James will be appointed to the new position of Communications and Community Engagement Administrator.
