JROTC Rifle Marksmanship

- Popular activity with JROTC cadets with 40 of our very own showing an interest in joining.
- Governed by Cadet Command Regulations.
- Uses a 4.5mm(.177 cal) pellet at 10 M.
- Cadets learn firearm safety.

Curriculum

- While Safety is our number one goal in JROTC there are three steps to the marksmanship curriculum.
 - Classroom Learning
 - Maintenance
 - Hands on training

After all of these have been completed and cadets have passed certification tests they will be ready for open practice.

Safety

- Safety during training and competitions is our number one concern.
- Before ever handling a rifle cadets must first complete a safety training course.
- Strict safety guidelines both on, and off the range ensure a disciplined and conscious awareness of our Cadets actions.

Learning to handle guns safely

- The goal: eliminate all gun accidents.
- Know primary gun parts that affect safety.
- Practice handling air rifles, safety comes from practice, and knowledge.
- Safe gun handling rules apply to all guns and firearms.

 - BHS aux Gym
 - BHS Industrial Education rooms
 - Outdoors on BHS grounds
 - National Guard Armory
