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Background Information:

The Board previously approved the addition of tennis courts to this project based on the recommendation of Administration that the tennis courts are at the same location as the Complex and combining the projects was more cost efficient. Claycomb and Associates is the architect on this project. They developed the plans for the Complex, including the tennis courts. Administration issued a Request for Proposals under Competitive Sealed Proposal procurement with the full plans and specifications. We have received one bid, which is over budget. We are asking the Board to consider options including increasing the budget, selecting a value engineering option (which will be proposed at the meeting by Administration), or withdraw the bids and re-bid this project.

Fiscal Implications:

The budget for the Baseball/Softball Complex was \$8.5 million; the estimated cost for the addition of the tennis courts was \$1.8 million; the budget for the Baseball/Softball Refresh was \$2.3 million; \$1 million was reallocated from the Performing Arts Center for a total of \$13.6 million. If the budget is increased, then the fiscal impact will be that additional amount.

Administration asks that the Board consider the options as presented by Administration and select one so that Administration can move forward.
