Subject: 2022 Kids' College Facilities Rental Agreement with Fort Bend Independent School District (ISD)

**Recommendation:** Approve Continuing Education (CE) Department to engage in a Kids' College facilities rental agreement with Fort Bend Independent School District (FBISD) for Summer 2022.

## **Background and Rationale:**

The CE Department seeks approval to rent a facility from Fort Bend ISD that is conducive to the variety of courses offered by Kids' College. The quote from FBISD is \$90,440 and includes the rental of two gyms, science labs, kitchens/cooking areas, art studio, woodworking shop, theater room, dance rooms, tennis courts, common areas (cafeterias, hallways, and atriums), performance stage, several classrooms, and building utilities. These amenities allow WCJC to offer two summer programs of enhanced educational and enrichment classes for students entering kindergarten through eighth grade.

WCJC plans to offer its 33<sup>rd</sup> year of Kids' College in 2022, and it is the 18<sup>th</sup> year to partner with FBISD for rental of their facility. Typically, Kids' College serves over 2,000 students and ends with a profit around \$200,000. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, WCJC did not offer a Kids' College program in 2020. WCJC held a scaled-down version of the program at the Richmond campus in 2021 that served only 268 students.

**District Fee Schedule** applied for the **gyms** and **cafeteria / commons**. The classrooms and libraries are not normally rented space, so they are not on our fee schedule. We applied our **HVAC** hourly rate to these areas using the **Energy Management Dept's zone map**. Kitchen serving line normally not available, but permit WCJC to use at a flat rate of \$1000 for the camp period.

**Custodians** work 7-5:30 during the summer. Assessed Custodial fee for:

6:30 a.m. - 7:00 a.m. in order to open the facility prior to 7:00 a.m. start

5:30 p.m. - 6:30 p.m. in order to clean WCJC area after use.

Total 2 hours / day custodial fee @ \$40/hour.
