


### General Fund Expenditures

The following graphs depict the percentage of expenditures by function in the General Fund. The allocation of expenditures between 2023 and 2024 has been very consistent from one year to the next.

The three instruction categories of regular, vocational, and special education comprise 65% and 66% of total expenditures for 2024 and 2023, respectively.

### 2025 – 2026 Budget

- ❖The annual audit was completed for the week of October 6th. No adjusting entries needed to be made.
- The budget report that is included in the October Board Consent Agenda section has updated beginning fund balances for FY26 which reflects how the budget performed in FY25.
- ❖ Enrollment is down compared to what had been budgeted. DES 8 fewer students than budgeted; DIS − 1 less student than budgeted; DHS − 34 fewer students than budgeted.
- In November, a budget revision will be done for all funds. At that time, the prior year audit will be completed, fall enrollment will be finalized and new staff information will be updated.
