INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT

BETWEEN

PANA SCHOOL DISTRICT #8

AND

RAMSEY COMMUNITY UNIT SCHOOL DISTRICT #204

This agreement is entered into by the **Pana School District #8** Board of Education, hereinafter referred to as "**Pana School District**" and the Ramsey Community Unit School District #204 hereinafter referred to as "Ramsey" for the purpose of sharing certain extracurricular athletic programs with eligible students from both school districts. The home school district will be **PANA**.

The sharing of extra-curricular athletic programs is allowed under IHSA by-laws.

This agreement will be effective and covers the 2025-2026 and 2026-2027 school years and indicated sports for those years.

Pana School will offer the following extra-curricular athletic programs and open them for participation to eligible students.

High School Soccer

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. The two districts will not charge each other for allowing students from the other districts to participate in any extra-curricular athletic program or for any costs involved in running any program. Total control of each extra-curricular athletic program remains solely with the district offering the program.
- 2. Students from all districts will follow and abide by the rules and regulation of the district offering the extra-curricular athletic program in which they are participating. (This includes paying of participation fees, athletics fees, etc.) The exception is that each student will be declared academically eligible or ineligible to participate by the district of residence.
- 3. Students who receive recognition of participation through the awarding of a letter will receive that letter from the district of residence. The district offering the extra-curricular athletic program will provide other awards such as pins, bars, trophies, plaques, etc.
- 4. Transportation to the district offering the extra-curricular athletic program will be the sole responsibility of the students' parents/guardians.
- 5. The host school will be responsible for providing equipment and compensation of the coaching personnel.

- 6. Each participating district will abide by their own existing Board of Education policies regarding school and student insurance and general liabilities.
- 7. The host school will provide and maintain appropriate facilities and equipment as outlines through IESA policy.
