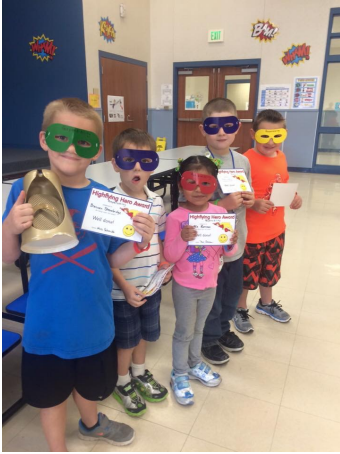
INNOVATIONS:

1. We are implementing phase II of a campus wide positive intervention support system. This plan includes Response to Intervention specifically targeted at teaching behaviors.
2. We have built an on-site training room to help teachers continue to be learners and to create an environment of continued learning among our faculty
3. We are in the process of creating a sensory diet space that will be utilized by regular and special education students that are in Tier II or Tier III of RTI B and require interventions that could be taught / fulfilled within that space. The outcome from this type of setting is to maximize instructional time by taking preventative measures once needs are identified.
4. Kindergarten is using a new version of our traditional report card that will provide more insight to parents regarding their child's progress towards specific skills / TEKS. (data based report card)
5. Campus wide use of google classroom and google educational tools to enhance communication and collaboration among staff.
