Principal's General Narrative:

We have had a very good year but we know we can always do better and that is what we will be striving for as we plan for the upcoming school year.

Summer school is underway (6-7-11) and we are beginning to prepare for the 2011-2012 school year. We will be working on ordering textbooks, completing student schedules, and updating the handbook, among many other things.

We are very proud to have been ranked near the top of Texas high schools in this study:

The non-profit research and educational group Children at Risk did a statewide study of Texas schools based on Texas Education Agency records, and ranked them statistically by academic performance. Children at Risk developed a ranking method based on 14 criteria, including completion of Advanced Placement courses, dual credit courses, SAT and ACT scores, attendance and graduation rates, which are adjusted for a school's percentage of economically disadvantaged students. On April 24, 2011 Children at Risk published their findings which showed Brackett High School near the top of high schools in the state of Texas, for the second year in a row.
