- Comply with policies and rules established by federal and state laws, State Board of Education rules, School District and IHSSAA.
- Performs such other tasks, related to coaching, which may be assigned by the Athletic Director or Building Principal.
- Observes sport participants during practice and workout sessions to detect and correct errors in activity procedures and method.

CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT:

- Assignment for a coaching position is for one school year only.
- Seniority shall not be considered in selection of a head coach nor assistant coaches unless skill and ability are equal in each sport. The most able, trained and skilled shall be the head coach and assistant coaches in each sport.
- No Coach shall allow a student to participate in after school activities while same interferes with a student's academic work, nor while suspended from school or activities for disciplinary reasons.
