 - Updated graduation information specific to our Social Studies realignment.

 - Updated language regarding Cum Laude to clarify eligibility.
- Page 28
 - CHS administration is proposing an additional disciplinary category that covers the derogatory use of religious, ethnic or sexual orientation language.
- Page 29
 - Language added to include “marijuana” in the description of a Tobacco, Alcohol and other Drug offense.
- Page 31
 - Language added to update dress code to include the wearing of hoodies, blankets and coats during the school day.
- Page 40
 - Language updated to include up-to-date devices regarding tobacco use.
