Summary:	Under House Bill 3 (HB 3), Texas school boards are required to set annual and long-term goals focused on improving student outcomes, particularly in early literacy and college, career, and military readiness (CCMR). The purpose of these goals is to align board governance with academic achievement, ensure transparency and accountability, and drive continuous improvement across all student groups. By focusing on measurable progress, HB 3 encourages school boards to prioritize student success and close achievement gaps, helping ensure every student is on track for long-term success.
